

DR. ALLEN S. SCHATNER EMS EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Allegheny County EMS Council is proud to announce the availability of scholarship funds for those persons who plan to pursue a career as an EMT Paramedic through local EMT Paramedic Training Programs.

The scholarship is named for Dr. Allen S. Schatner, a true pioneer in the local training and implementation of EMS Systems. The scholarship will be awarded to eligible recipients regardless of race, creed, color, religion or sex in accordance with Title IX, Section 504.

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicants must reside within Allegheny County, PA
 - Applicants must be certified as an EMT for a minimum of 1 year prior to the start of the EMT Paramedic Program.
 - Applicants must currently be an active EMT with a licensed EMS agency within Allegheny County.
 - Applicants must also have submitted an application to a PA Department of Health approved EMT Paramedic Training Program within Allegheny County.
 - Applicants must demonstrate financial need.
- Scholarship recipients will receive a \$500.00 scholarship to cover tuition and related expenses. The initial \$250.00 will be awarded upon successful enrollment in the EMT Paramedic Program directly to the training institute. The final \$250.00 will be reimbursed to the recipient upon successful completion of the program or as determined by the scholarship committee.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Applications must be accompanied by a letter of recommendation from the applications EMS Supervisor
- Successful applicants must report any other financial assistance for the program to the committee. Additional assistance may not be grounds for disqualification, however the committee reserves the right to reimburse EMS Agencies for co-sponsorship of students upon completion of the program.

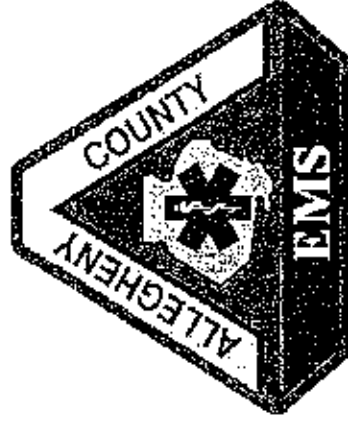
The funds for the Allen S. Schattner Scholarship have been donated by the many hospital and EMS Agency sponsors of the Council.
